Her novels «Season of Poisoned Fruit» and «Pavel Zhang and Other River Creatures» also made long lists for the Big Book and Yasnaya Polyana national awards. She is the winner of the special prize of the magazine «Yunost» in 2020 for «the masterful adherence to the canons of the genre and the freedom of novel breathing» for the novel «Pavel Zhang and Other River Creatures». Vera Bogdanova's stories were published in «Novy Mir», «Bookmate Journal» and «Yunost» magazines. She has authored articles for the magazines «Rules of Life», «Bitter», «Reading», «Friendship of Peoples», blog «Storytel». She has highlighted translation novelties for «Afisha Daily», and is the author of a blog about what's new on «The New York Times» bestseller list.

She speaks English and Japanese. She is currently living in Moscow.
